Prior his return, he was CEO of White Oak Resources LLC, a start-up energy company in Southern Illinois, where for two years he led a team of engineers and coal experts in the initial stages of development of an underground coal mine.

He was well suited for the role. He graduated from the University of Alabama with a degree in Mineral Engineering, and later added a Masters in Business Administration from that institution. He is a Registered Professional Engineer in the State of Alabama. He worked for Drummond for thirty years in a variety of mining roles with increasing responsibility before being appointed Vice President and Executive Assistant to the President in 1998. In 2004, he was elevated to the position of President of the Mining Division, a position he held until his departure to White Oak in late 2007.

After the completion of his MBA in 1986, he was assigned to a development team to study the feasibility of a coal mining project in Colombia. In 1990, he was named President of that division, leading to the opening of Mina Pribbinow in 1994, one of the largest mining complexes in the world, which now produces more than twenty-five million tons of coal a year for export to markets in Europe, Israel, and this country.

Mike is married to the former Becky Dawkins of Northport and they have three daughters and three grandsons.
