## **General Charles Campbell** *Commanding General* *U.S. Army Forces Command*

General Charles C. Campbell assumed duties as the Commander, United States Army Forces Command, at Fort McPherson, Georgia, on 9 January 2007, becoming the 17<sup>th</sup> officer to hold this position. As the Commander of the Army's largest organization, he is responsible for the oversight, manning, training, and equipping of 750,000 Active Duty, Reserve, and National Guard Soldiers when mobilized for combat operations.

General Campbell earned his commission through ROTC at Louisiana State University in 1970. He has extensive Combined Arms and Joint command and staff experience. General Campbell served as the commander of a Special Operations A-Detachment in Vietnam, an armor battalion in the 3d Armored Division, a mechanized brigade in the 2d Infantry Division, and as the Commanding General of the 7<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division. Prior to moving to Fort McPherson for duty as the Deputy Commander at US Army Forces Command, he was the Commanding General for Eighth Army, Republic of Korea.

His Army and Joint level staff experience includes service as a Plans and Operations Officer, Combined Field Army, United States Forces Korea; the Chief of Staff, United States Central Command; and Chief of Staff, United Nations Command/Combined Forces Command/United States Forces Korea.

General Campbell holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in History from Louisiana State University and a Master of Military Art and Science from the United States Army Command and General Staff College. He has attended a wide variety of military schools, culminating with his graduation from the Army War College in 1991.

His military awards and decorations include the Distinguished Service Medal, Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit (with 3 Oak Leaf Clusters), Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal (with 5 Oak Leaf Clusters), Army Commendation Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), Army Achievement Medal, Special Forces Tab, and Parachutist Badge.

The United States Army Forces Command (FORSCOM) is located at Fort McPherson, Georgia in the heart of the city of Atlanta. Fort McPherson is also home to the Third United States Army and the U.S. Army Reserve Command. Fort McPherson's nearest Army neighbor and sub-installation, Fort Gillem is located in nearby Forest Park, Georgia, another suburb of Atlanta and is the home of the First United States Army. Fort McPherson and Fort Gillem share common services and morale support activities, and host The Army Ground Forces Band and many other units and activities.
