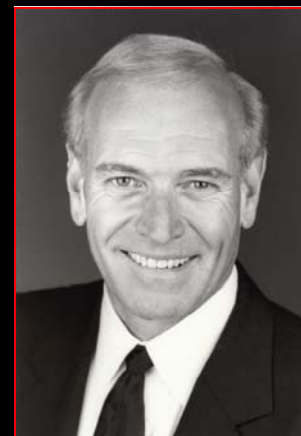

Drayton Nabers, Jr. is the former Chief Justice of the Alabama Supreme Court. He was appointed by the Governor in 2003 to assume responsibilities as the State of Alabama Finance Director and is retired CEO and Chairman of the Board of Protective Life Corporation. He is currently a Shareholder in the law firm of Maynard, Cooper & Gale, P.C. He graduated from Princeton University in 1962 and earned his law degree from Yale School of Law in 1965. After his clerkship for Justice Hugo Black of the United States Supreme Court in 1965 and 1966, he joined the law firm of Cabaniss, Johnston, Gardner, Dumas and O'Neal of Birmingham, Alabama. He became a partner of that firm in 1971 and remained such until he joined Protective Life Corporation in 1979 and rose to Chief Executive Officer in 1992. He serves on the corporate boards of ProAssurance Corporation and Infinity Property and Casualty Corporation and is a member of the Alabama Academy of Honor. He has served the insurance industry as both Director and Chairman of the American Council of Life Insurers.

Mr. Nabers' many civic contributions include Chairman, District 7, Rhodes Scholarship Selection Committee; Chairman, Cornerstone School of Alabama; Distinguished Lecturer, Beeson Divinity School; Chairman, Leadership Birmingham and Chairman and Campaign Chairman, United Way of Central Alabama.

A commitment to community service runs in Drayton's family, his Grandfather, J.D. Porter was a distinguished past president of the Kiwanis Club of Birmingham in 1930. Drayton has been a member of the Kwianis Cub since 1974

Mr. Nabers is married to Fairfax Smathers and they enjoy three children and six grandchildren. He is a member at St. Luke's Episcopal Church.
