Major General James O. Barclay, III Commanding General United States Army Aviation Center of Excellence and Fort Rucker



Major General James O. Barclay III was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant of Infantry from the United States Military Academy on June 7, 1978.

Major General Barclay has served in various aviation and infantry units, and has commanded at the company, battalion and brigade levels, with service in Operations Provide Comfort in Iraq, Uphold Democracy in Haiti and Iraqi Freedom in Iraq.

His most recent assignment was as the Director of the Joint Center for Operational Analysis (JCOA), United States Joint Forces Command. Previous to this assignment, Major General Barclay was assigned to 1st Infantry Division as the Deputy Commanding General (maneuver). His Joint assignments include Deputy Division Chief, United States Atlantic Command and Executive Officer to the Commander, Multi-National Forces-Iraq.

Major General Barclay holds a Bachelor's degree from the United States Military Academy and a Master's degree in National Security and Strategic Studies from the United States Naval War College.

His decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Bronze Star Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Defense Meritorious Service Medal (with 2 Oak Leaf Clusters), the Meritorious Service Medal (with 5 Oak Leaf Clusters), the Army Commendation Medal (with Oak Leaf Cluster), the Army Achievement Medal, the Senior Army Aviator Badge, the Parachutist Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.

His wife, Deborah, joins him at Fort Rucker. They have three children, Mary Margaret, living in Houston, Texas; a son, Jae, living in Huntsville, Alabama; and Bill, a Warrant Officer attending flight school at Fort Rucker.
