- ◆ Normally, the recipient should be the chief executive and/or founder of a company or in a major leadership role of a company or organization that had developed, matured or expanded under his/her leadership.
- ◆ The individual receiving the award has demonstrated leadership that is responsible for substantial positive change in commerce, industry, education, employment or other areas and may be living or deceased.
- ◆ Nominees should be leaders of enterprises located in the Greater Birmingham area.
- ◆ Consideration will also be given to institutional change and its positive growth/impact to the Greater Birmingham community, job creation, economic contribution and any other positive impact on the Birmingham area.
