

A Salute to the Veterans of WWII



The year 2009 marks not only the seventieth anniversary of the beginning of the Second World War in Europe but the sixty-fifth anniversary of a number of critical events in that conflict. Those events included the Normandy invasion, the capture of Rome and the liberation of Paris, amphibious attacks on the islands of New Guinea, Tinian, Saipan, and Guam, the return of American forces to the Philippines, the airborne assaults of Operation Market-Garden, the brutal battle of the Hürtgen Forest, and the opening salvos of the Battle of the Bulge.

Therefore, this year the Kiwanis Club of Birmingham is diverting from its usual programs of guest speakers in order to honor and commemorate those members of its club who served in uniform in the Allies' military forces during the Second World War. These men include **Harry Benjamin, James Callaway, George Edwards, Marvin Engel, Carl Jernigan, Wayne Killion, Sr., Atley Kitchings, Jr., Lee Lloyd, Dr. Charles Lokey, Malcolm Miller, Henry G. Seibels, Jr., Dr. Sheridan Shirley, Owen Sims, Grady Smith, and Harold Williams.** In total, these veterans served in the Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and even the Canadian Navy in virtually every theater of the war. Their stories are worth hearing and acknowledging; their sacrifices are worth remembering. Not coincidentally, this special program will take place on Tuesday, November 10, 2009 – the day before our nation celebrates Veterans Day.
