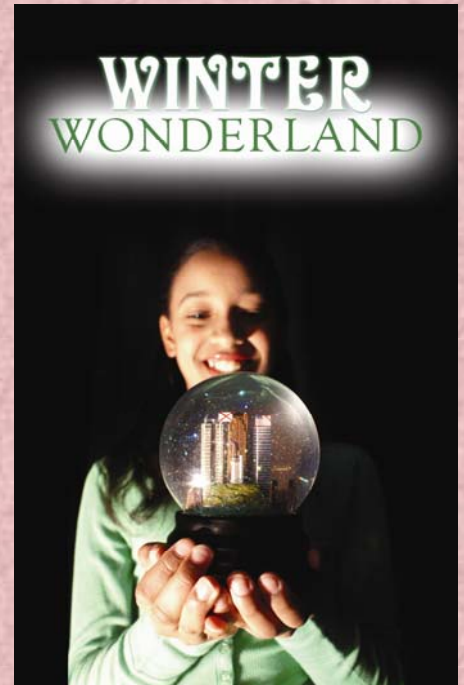
RMTC recently kicked off their 30th Anniversary Season with a Matching Fund Initiative, led by a generous gift of \$250,000 a year for three years, to be matched by community and individual contributions with the goal of raising a minimum of \$1.5 million by the end of 2011. If successful, this funding initiative will offset the loss of government funding from the Jefferson County Community Arts Fund and allow RMTC to maintain its current programming level, while increasing its ability to serve the community through outreach opportunities.

RMTC's 30th Anniversary season includes popular favorites like *Dreamgirls* (October 2-19, 2008), *Winter Wonderland* (December 4-14, 2008), *The Odd Couple: Female Version* (February 19-March 1, 2009), *Sweeney Todd* (April 30-May 10, 2009) and *The Producers* (July 16-August 2, 2009).
